Dear Parent or Guardian:

The School Code of Illinois and the Department of Health have the following requirements to enter high school. Non-compliance of a current physical or immunizations will delay receiving a schedule.

1. All students entering high school for the first time must have a complete physical examination reported on the specific State of Illinois "Certificate of Child Health Exam" form, signed by a licensed physician, APN, or PA. This includes all freshmen and transfer students.
2. **All immunization dates since birth must be recorded (month, date, and year) on the top portion of the physical exam form. They must meet required standards of the Illinois Department of Public Health and be signed by your physician or health care professional.** Your Junior High has health records on file until the end of the school year. Obtaining a copy of the 6<sup>th</sup> grade physical may help your physician complete the immunization section of this form.
  - One dose of Tetanus Diphtheria, Pertussis – (Tdap)
  - Two (2) doses of Measles, Mumps and Rubella vaccine (**the 1<sup>st</sup> dose having been given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday**).
  - The **last** Polio booster must have been given **on or after** the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
  - Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
  - Two doses Varicella vaccine (**the 1<sup>st</sup> dose having been given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday**).
  - Two doses Meningococcal vaccine **or one dose on or after the 16<sup>th</sup> birthday** required for all seniors
3. **Please complete and sign the Health History section on the back of the physical form.** If this mandatory section is incomplete or unsigned, the physical will be returned to you.
4. Make a copy for your records.
5. If your student is in sports, this physical can be used as a sports physical for thirteen months. In order to be eligible for the complete school year, it should be dated after May 1<sup>st</sup>. **Make a copy of the physical to give to the coach. Send the original to the Nurse's Office.**
6. Dental examinations are strongly recommended, but not required for entrance into school.
7. **Pink emergency sheets must be completed and returned to the Nurse's Office.** This form allows the school to follow your directions regarding whom to call should your child become ill or need medical care here at school.

**I urge you to make your appointment for a physical exam with your physician or clinic as soon as possible.** The Orland Township provides immunization clinics and physical examinations. They can be reached at 403-4222.

**Physicals, immunizations, and pink emergency sheets are due in the Nurse's Office by June 1. Any deficiencies with these requirements will not allow you to participate in on-line school registration, receive a schedule, or to start school on time.**
